Genesis, Vision, Mission & Goal

Genesis

he Trust for Advancement of Agricultural Sciences (TAAS) is an outcome of the 88th Session of Indian Science Congress held under the General Presidentship of Dr RS Paroda at the Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI), New Delhi on 3-6 January, 2001. The theme of the Congress was "Food, Nutrition and Environmental Security". During the Congress, former Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee released the following Vision Statement:

"By 2020, India will be free of poverty, hunger and malnutrition, and become an environmentally safe country. This, we believe, will be possible to achieve through accelerated social and economic development by harnessing the advances in science, and blending them with our indigenous knowledge, wisdom and unique socio-cultural ethos. We believe India can banish poverty and emerge as a developed nation by promoting growth through efficient and sustainable use of our human, natural and other resources". The Vision Statement concluded stating: "Hunger free India is an idea whose time has come. Let us launch a science-based crusade for elimination of hidden hunger and malnutrition".

Also, the Prime Minister exhorted the scientists by stating "Our goal to make India a leading nation in the world in the new century hinges critically on how successfully we take science to the people and create a stronger scientific temper in our society".

In response to the above, and considering the fact that the Congress should not be seen as an end in itself and that there is need for a movement for harnessing, in particular, the agricultural science for the welfare of the people, the National Organizing Committee of the Congress decided to form a Trust for Advancement of Agricultural Sciences (TAAS). Accordingly, the Trust was established on 17 October, 2002 with its Headquarters at the Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI), New Delhi.

1. Dr MS Swaminathan Award for Leadership in Agriculture

he Trust for Advancement of Agricultural Sciences (TAAS) instituted "Dr MS Swaminathan Award for Leadership in Agriculture" in the honour of Bharat Ratna Awardee Dr MS Swaminathan, the Father of Green Revolution in India. This prestigious award was instituted in 2004 with an aim to recognize the life time contributions of eminent persons who have made global impact in the field of agriculture, especially towards food, nutrition and environmental sustainability. The award carries a citation and the plaque of honour.

TAAS has so far conferred this Award for Leadership in Agriculture on 14 global leaders in recognition of their outstanding lifetime contributions in the field of agriculture, with greater impact on Indian agriculture. These include: Nobel Laureate Dr Norman E Borlaug, Dr GS Khush, Dr Surinder K Vasal, Prof Rattan Lal, Dr Sanjay Rajaram, Dr Mohan C Saxena, Dr William D Dar, Dr Thomas Lumpkin, Dr Uma Lele, Dr John Dixon, Dr Shenggen Fan, Dr Adel El-Beltagy, Dr Surinder (Suri) M Sehgal and Dr Kamal Bawa. 




2. Dr SK Vasal Award for Excellence in Crop Hybrid Research

r SK Vasal Award for Excellence in Crop Hybrid Research has been instituted by TAAS in 2024 to honor the enormous contributions of Dr Surinder K Vasal, a world renowned maize breeder and a World Food Prize Laureate for his outstanding work, especially the development of quality protein maize and other hybrids. The award is instituted through an endowment established at TAAS (www.taas.in) through a contribution by Dr Vasal. The objective of the award is to recognize the contributions of eminent scientists (both men and

women) who have made outstanding contributions in developing promising hybrids and designing new innovative strategies for hybrid development in crops. The Award carries a cash prize of INR one lakh, a citation and the plaque.
